Education and Experience

Scot Some earned his Master of Science in Traditional Chinese Medicine degree from the Colorado School of Traditional Chinese Medicine. This three-year program consists of 2850 hours of education including 750 hours of clinical practice. He was certified as a Diplomate in Acupuncture and Traditional Chinese Medicine by the National Certification Commission for Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine (NCCAOM) in June 2006. This includes certification in Clean Needle Technique.

Scot's training includes adjunctive therapies such as moxibustion, tui na, acupressure, cupping, auricular therapy, and TCM dietary and lifestyle recommendations.

Scot is a member of the Acupuncture Association of Colorado and the American Association of Oriental Medicine. He is a licensed acupuncturist in Colorado. None of these licenses, certificates, or registrations has ever been suspended or revoked.

Additionally, Scot earned his Masters in Business Administration from the University of Denver in August, 1998 and his Bachelors of Science in Engineering from the United States Naval Academy in May, 1990. He currently serves as a Commander in the US Navy Reserves.
